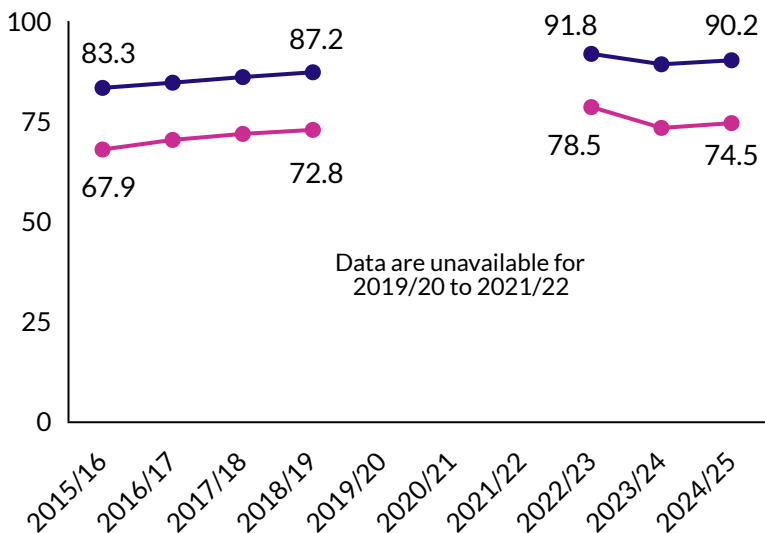

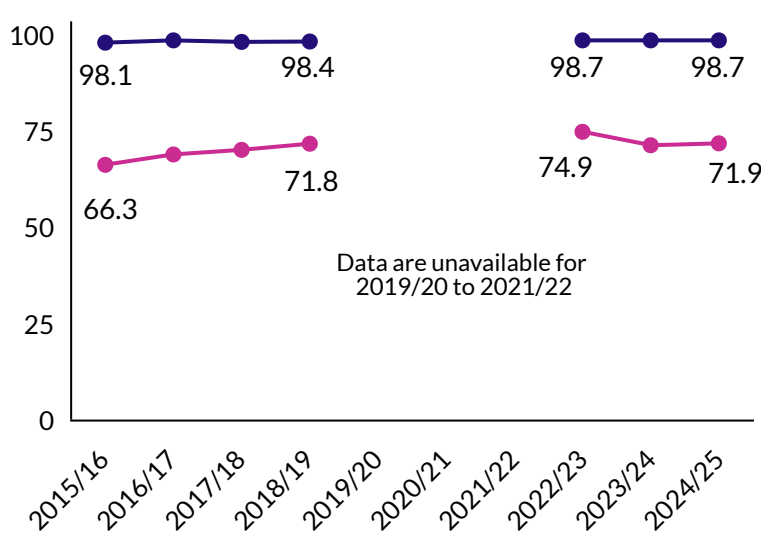
Year 12 GCSE Examination Results

Year 14 A-level Examination Results

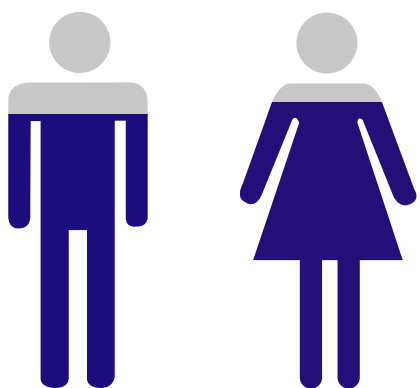
- % achieving 2+ A-levels at grades A*-E

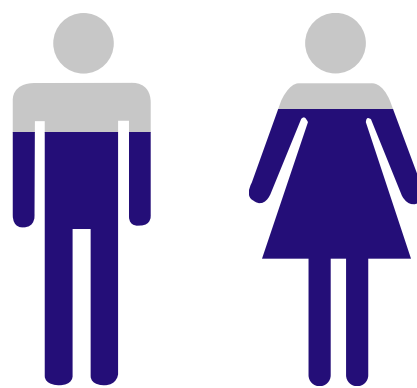

Male: 72.7% Female: 76.3%

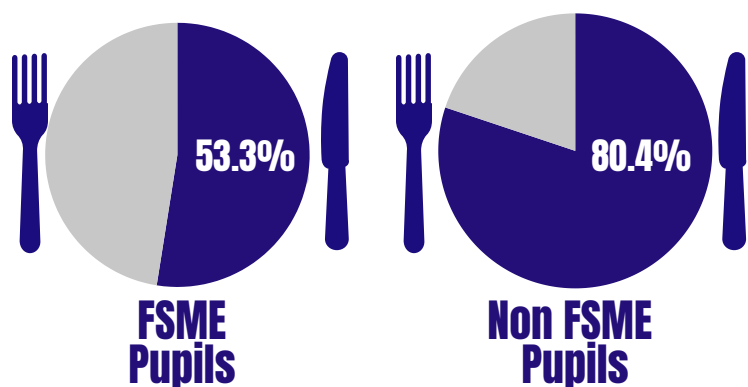
Pupils achieving 3+ A-levels at grades A*-C

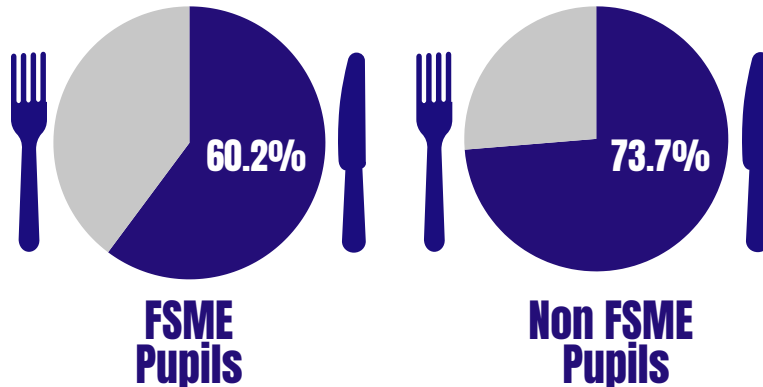
