Good afternoon,

To whom it may concern,

I am an outreach teacher, based in a special school in Dundonald. My role means I represent SENIS in many different schools in the province. Recently I have been working in St Joseph's PS, Strangford, where I have been received warmly.

The school has grown in numbers and space is at a premium. I find myself sharing a mobile with the principal on one of her principal release days. We feel this undermines the individual tuition I am offering during my weekly one hour visits. The principal works on confidential material during my visits. This room also operates as a library and reading resource facility. There are constant disruptions to the time I spend with the individual pupil who has additional needs. This is very distracting for him.

The principal seeks to increase suitable space both for her own private working venue and to provide appropriate areas for visiting staff. I support her in her venture to benefit the whole school community. This would give her the privacy she requires for this demanding and sensitive role.
