Mercy College, Belfast

Notice is hereby given that a proposal, under Article 14 of the Education and Libraries (NI) Order 1986, has been submitted to the Education Authority (Belfast Region) by the Council for Catholic Maintained Schools on behalf of the Trustees of Mercy College to the effect that:

It is proposed to increase the admission number of Mercy College from 110 to 115 and the enrolment number from 650 to 750 and become co-educational with effect from 1 September 2017 or as soon as possible thereafter.

(This proposal is linked to and dependent upon Development Proposal Nos 440, 441, 442 and 444.)

In pursuance of Article 14 of the Education and Libraries (NI) Order 1986, this proposal has been submitted by the Education Authority to the Department of Education for approval.
