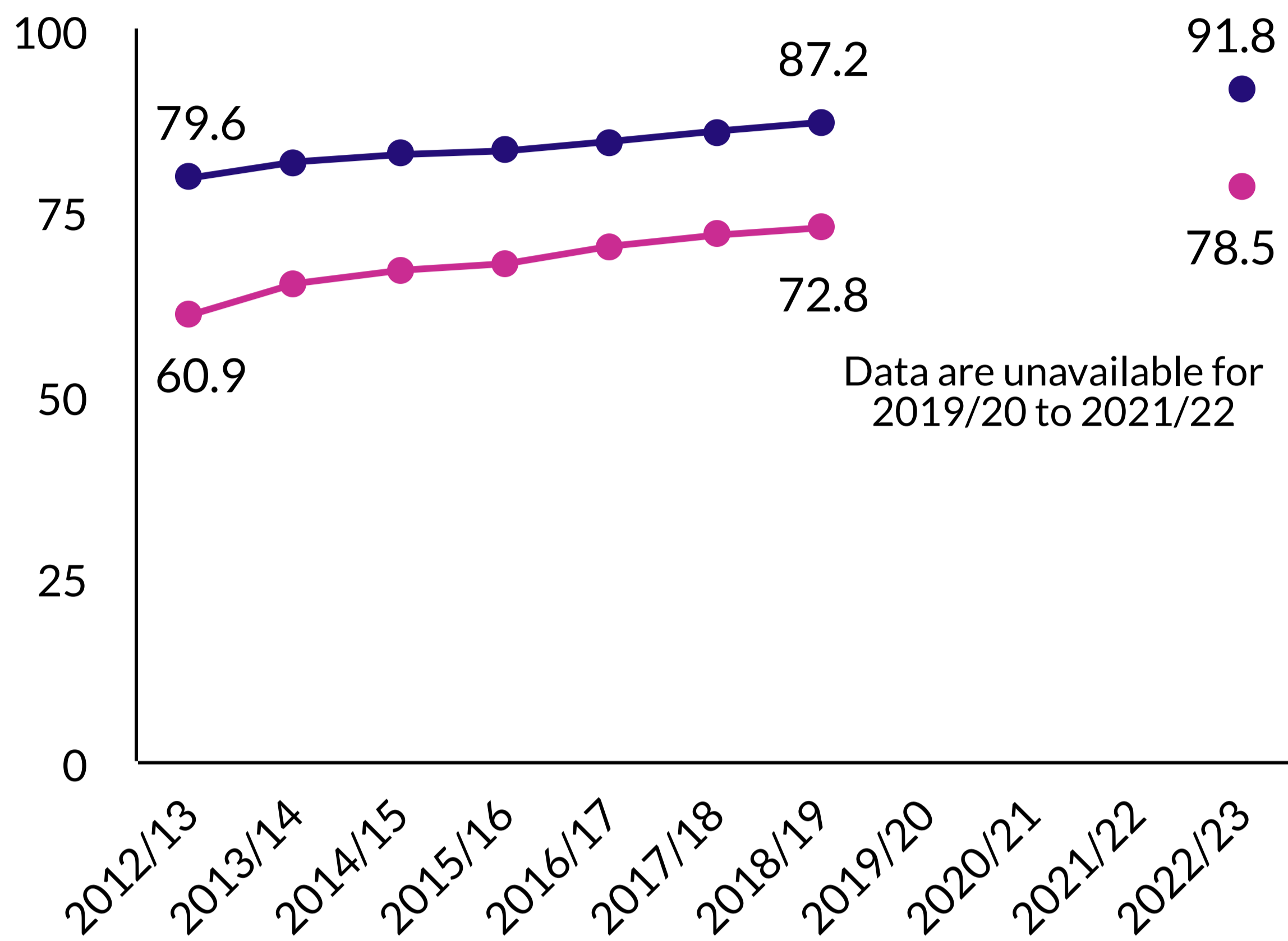

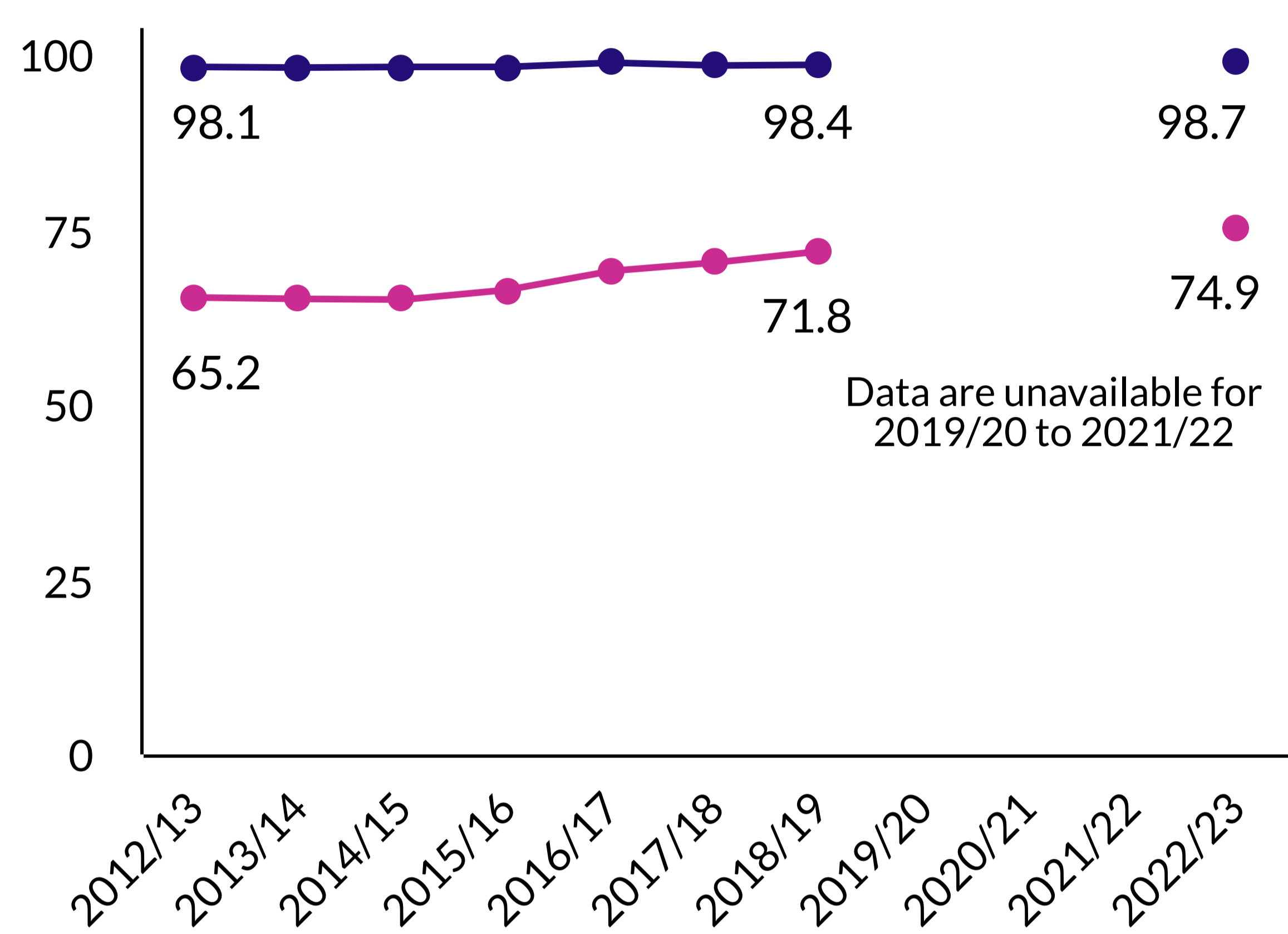
**Year 12 GCSE Examination Results**

- % achieving 5+ GCSEs A\*-C incl. GCSE English & maths



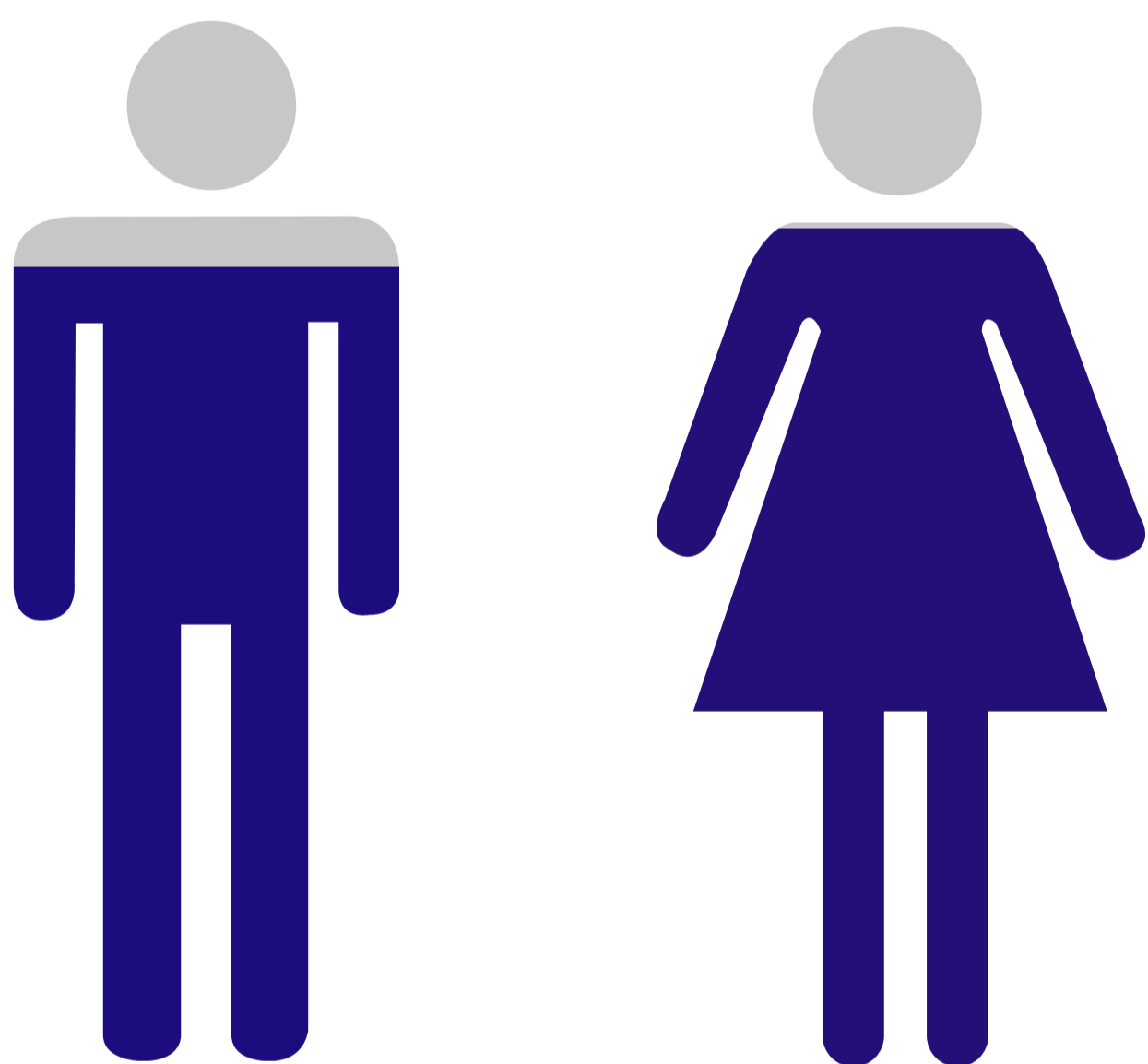
**Year 14 A-level Examination Results**

- % achieving 3+ A-levels at grades A\*-C



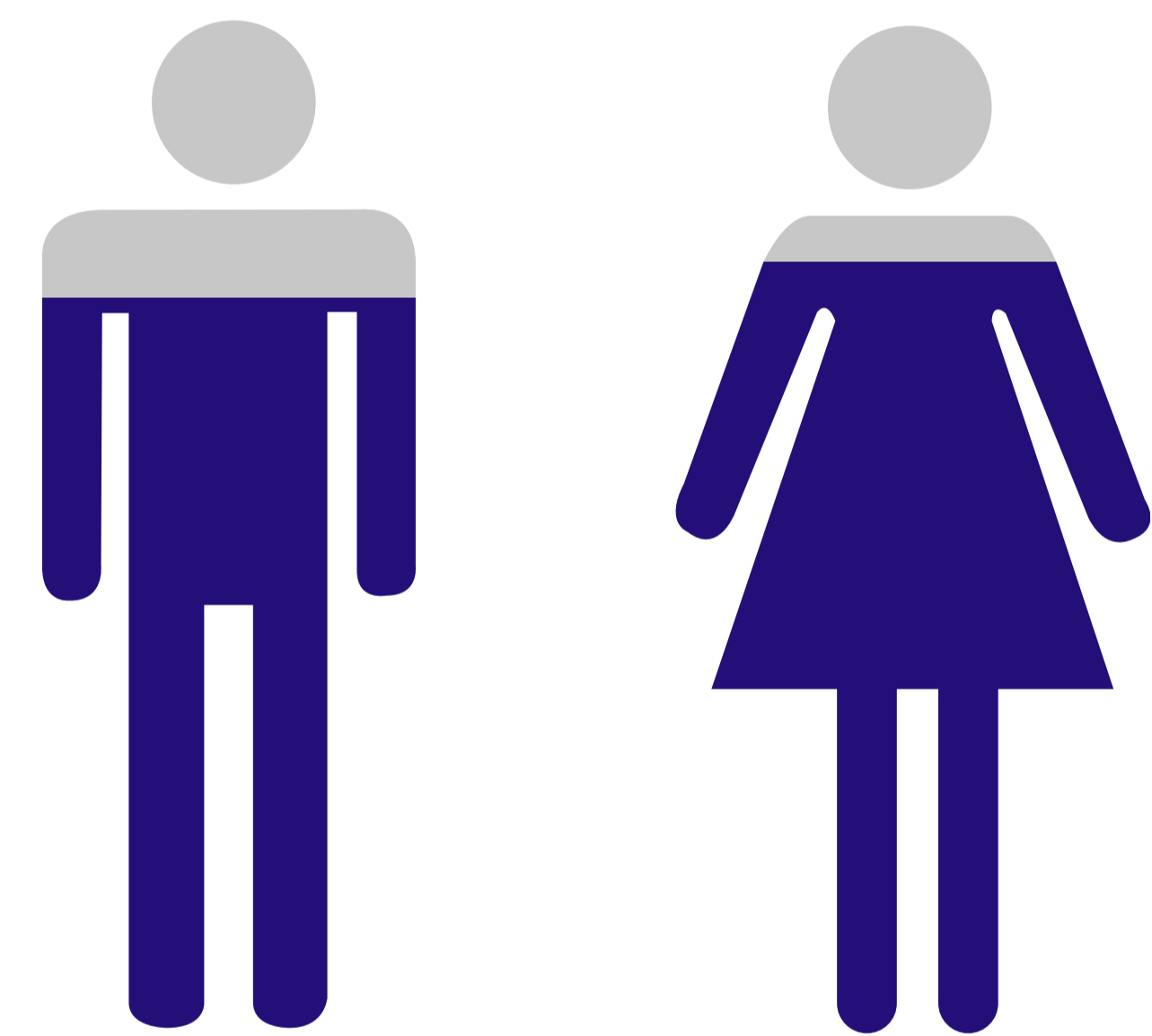

**Male: 76.3% Female: 80.6%**

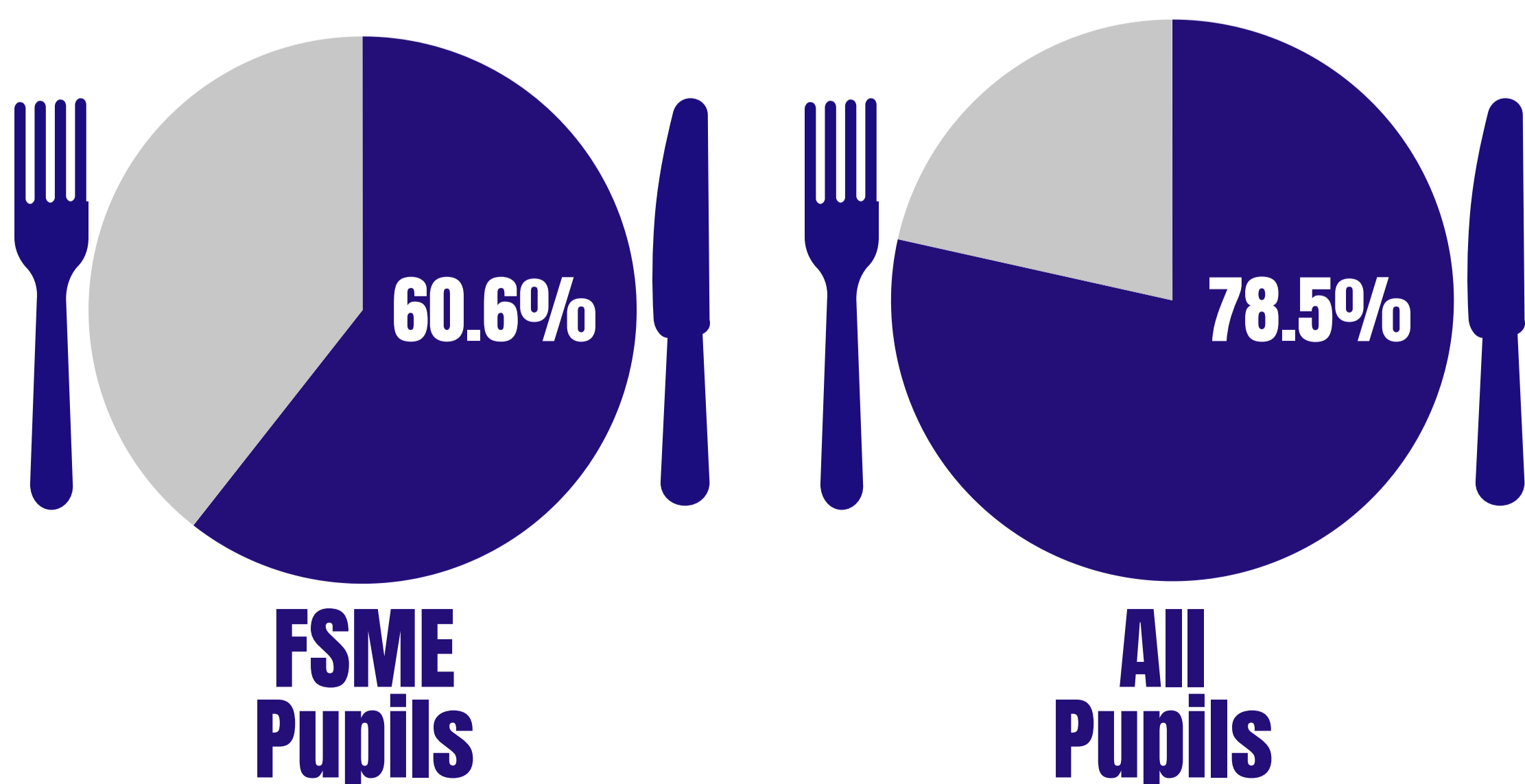
**Pupils achieving 3+ A-levels at grades A\*-C**
