

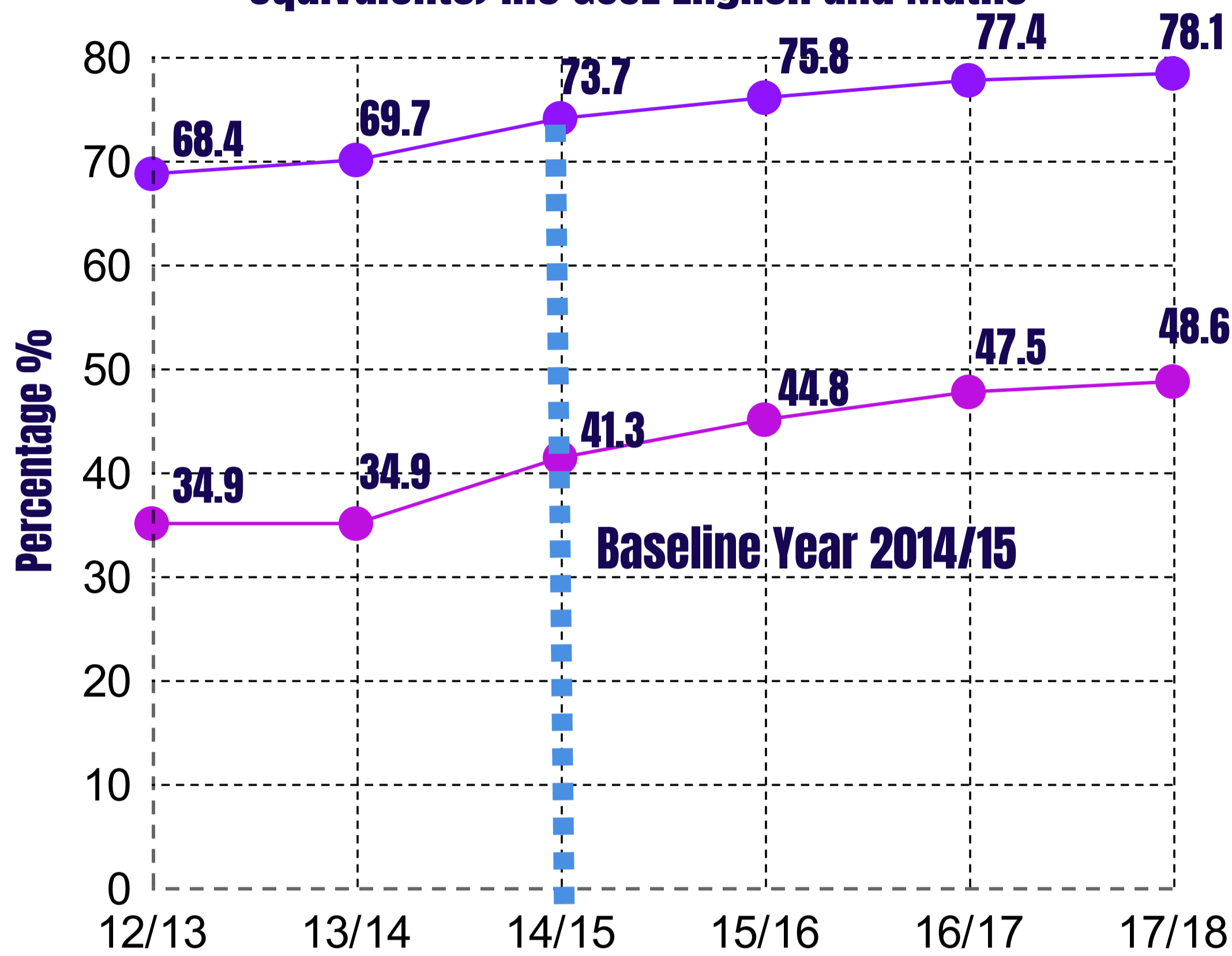
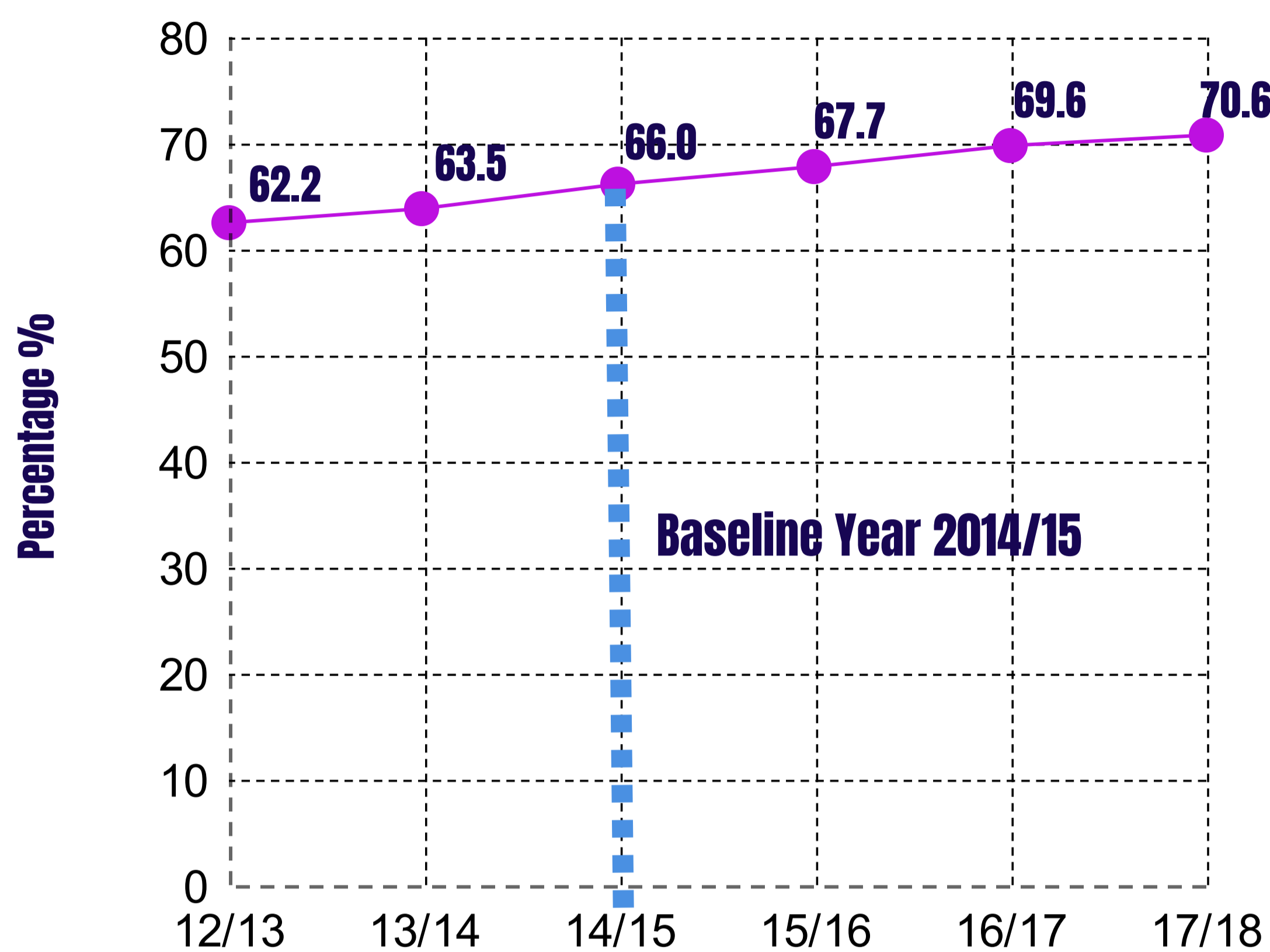

FSME and Non FSME pupils achieving at least 5 GCSEs A*-C (or equivalents) inc GCSE English and Maths

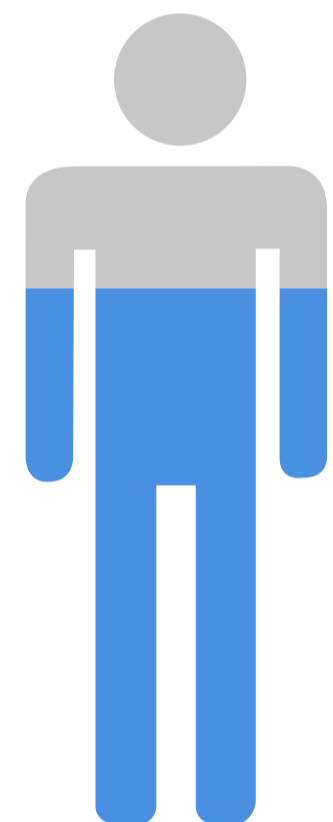
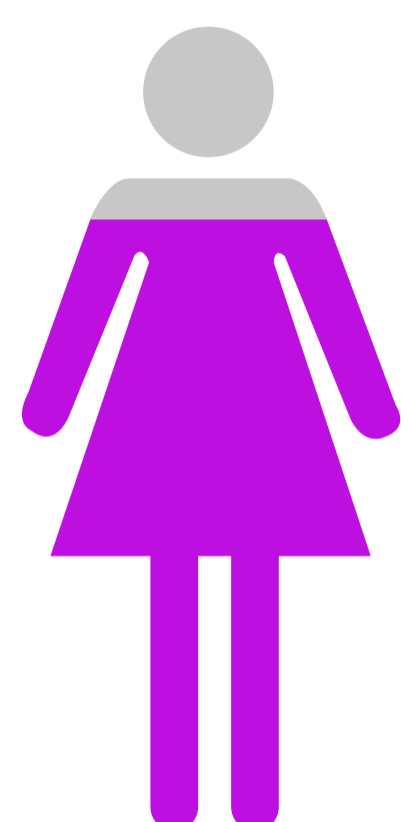

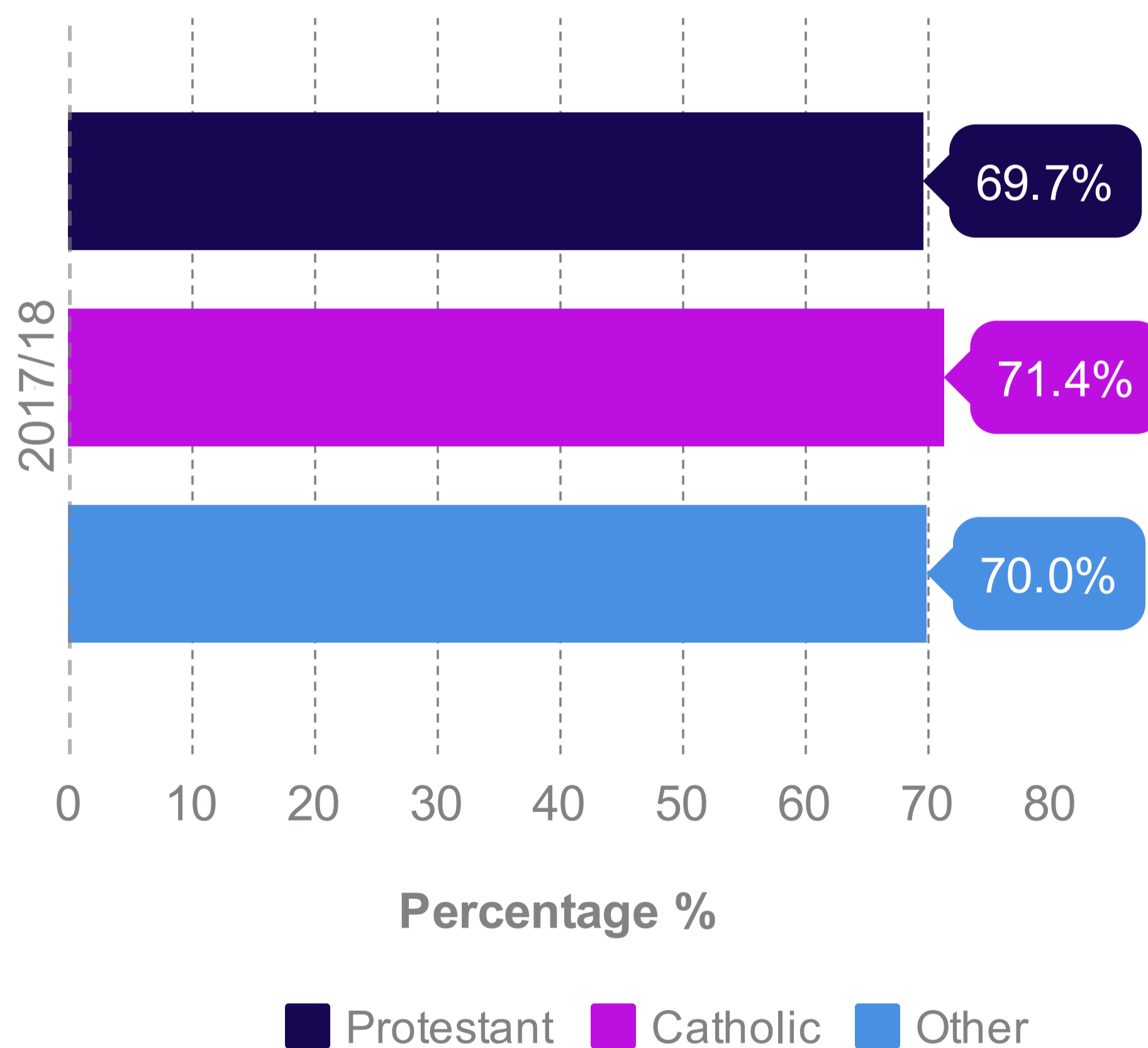
75.6% of girls achieved at least 5 GCSEs A*-C (or equivalent) inc GCSE English and Maths
